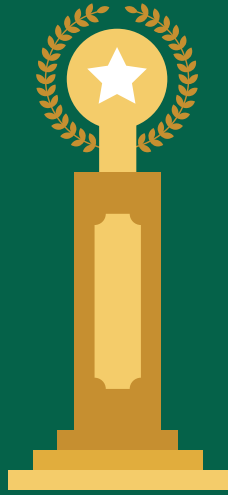

“On Friday March 30th the high school students of the Kyiv International School presented to their peers from Donetsk region feminist theatrical performance “Reviving Ophelia”.

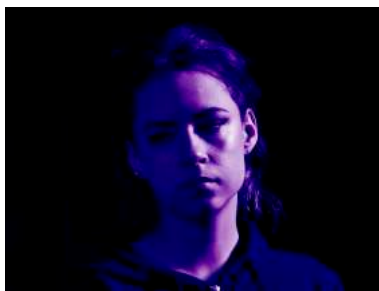
The book “Reviving Ophelia”, written by Dr. Mary Pipher and adapted into the a Theatre for young people script by the playwright Cherry Bennett, is an exciting story of four girls who are struggling with aggressive influence of popular culture and looking for their own way.

The play depicts the way of life for girls and obstacles that are on their way to realizing themselves, from the first grade and before the beginning of their adult life after graduation. After the performance teens from the Kyiv International School - QSI and their guests from Donetsk region discussed the key issues which women and girls face in Ukraine, referring to the story of the heroines of the "Reviving Ophelia". During the discussion, young people raised such topics as feminism, sexism, and violence against women and girls.

The premiere was held in partnership with Kramatorsk City Council and the Kyiv International School, within UN Women-UNDP Joint Programme “Restoration of Governance and Reconciliation in the Crisis-Affected Communities of Ukraine”, funded by the European Union in Ukraine.”

Paskha Baskets

For more than seven years now, the seven year old classes have been learning about the Ukrainian art of egg decorating and making paskha (which is Ukrainian Easter bread). The students went in groups to the cafeteria. The first day they made the bread and the second day they decorated the bread and eggs. In our international school, students, regardless of nationality or beliefs, can learn about the culture of the country in which they live. I am thankful for our seven year old teachers that help our students learn about traditions in Ukraine. It allows our students to learn about the world around them in concrete hands-on ways.



Bandura

The bandura is one of the most famous traditional Ukrainian instruments. On **Wednesday 18 April at 13:15**, in our school auditorium, we have the privilege to have Roman Hrynkiv and Larysa Dedyukh to present and perform a variety of musical numbers using the bandura and voice accompaniment. Roman Hrynkiv is one of Ukraine's most prominent and leading solo bandura performers as well as a professor at Tchaikovsky National Music Academy of Ukraine. As well as perform, he has designed and created his own type of bandura which he will share. He and Larysa Dedyukh will present to our elementary students ages seven years old and older this fascinating Ukrainian instrument along with some history into the creation of the bandura. We are fortunate indeed to have the opportunity to invite such an experienced musician to teach our children about Ukrainian traditional stringed instruments.

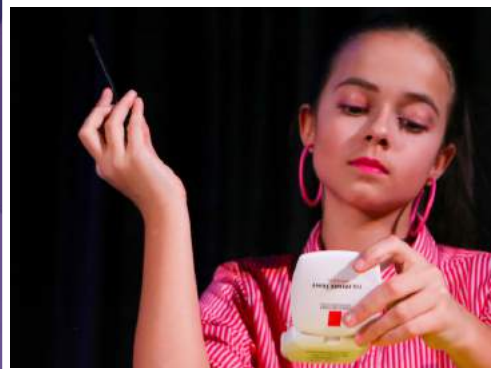

It was a great event, full of happiness, gratitude, joy and laughter.

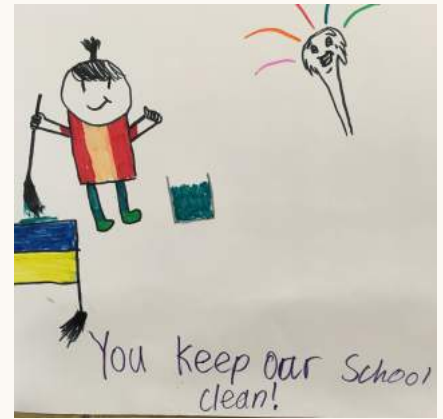
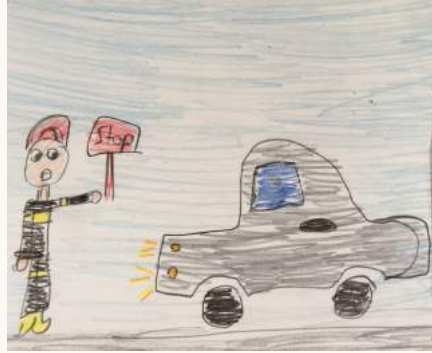
Families brought in treats, drinks, and donations. We were able to give out gift bags to each individual. Different classes made thank you cards and wrote thank you letters to everyone.
