We were engaged in various meetings over the couple of days he was here, so unfortunately there wasn't as much "free" time for him to walk around the school and meet people as we might usually like, but at the same time, I think that his experience here was a positive one, and I was glad to see the welcome that he received from those who met him.

At this point, we will be taking further steps toward our transition time. While I am still very much the director here, and Mr. Woodruff is still working hard in Dongguan, China, there are a few steps that we go through to make this transition smooth.

Part of this has already started to happen: I am including Mr. Woodruff on communications that will affect him in the future. These include personnel and budgeting decisions, but they may also include individual issues that may come across his desk next year. The frequency of these communications will increase as the spring rolls on and he will be included as much as is possible and logical into any important decisions we need to make.

Officially, Mr. Woodruff will start his responsibilities as the director of Kyiv International School on July 1, 2017, though even this time will be a transition period, as I will still need to respond to budgeting and spending issues that relate to the current school year. And of course, as I will continue working with QSI, though in a different capacity, I will be available to answer any questions and to assist with things here at the school while Mr. Woodruff is getting adjusted to life here at Kyiv International School.




